Pathways Board President and Interim Executive Director Last month, Dr. George resigned as our Executive Director. We are grateful for Dr. George's service to our organization for the past year and a half. Among other things, during his tenure Dr. George

- Helped organize and train a team of six National Trainers who lead the online Community Trainer training events.
- Revised Companionship Workshop Curriculum: This rewrite preserved the core content of Companionship while revamping both the instructor and participant guides. The updated materials reduce preparation time, script the training for ease of delivery, and cater to diverse adult learning preferences.
- Created Video Resources: These include 22 "Mental Health Minute" videos, a video succinctly describing the need for and practice of Companionship, and a video introducing Pathways to Promise.
- Wrote a Grant Proposal: secured a significant grant for Pathways for 2024 from a foundation.
